## **SPARKLING WINE**

#### Prosecco Asolo Superiore, Veneto, £34.99

A light, delicate sparkling wine, with aromas and flavours of honeysuckle, pears and apples. The bubbles are fine and persistent, offering a soft and luxurious mouthfeel.

## Pink Rose`, Serafini & Vidotto, Bollicine Rose, Veneto, £39

A fresh sparkling rose with a dry finish, persistence of soft fruit and flower scents accompanied by a fresh creamy mouth feel.

## Ferrari Maximum, Blanc de Blancs, Trentino, £56

Light straw yellow in colour with a fine perlage. It shows pleasant fruit aromas with hints of bread crust and hazelnut. The palate is elegant with a very persistent velvety texture with a light fruity note of ripe apples, pleasant hints of yeast and sweet almonds and a faintly aromatic quality that is typical of Chardonnay

## `Alma` Franciacorta Gran Cuvée Brut, Lombardy, 37.5cl £39 - 75cl £56

Pale yellow in colour, with marked greenish reflections and fine and continuous bubbles. It has an inviting bouquet with rich notes of white flowers, ripe fruit and subtle hints of vanilla, the aromas follow through on to the palate. Fine, elegant and beautifully balanced; this is a popular and fashionable option.

## Ferrari Maximum, Rose`, Trentino, £60.99

Elegant pink hue with a persistent perlage. The nose shows delicate aromas of yeast, deriving from the long bottle ageing, and berries that are typical of Pinot Noir. The palate has flavours of raspberry, wild strawberry and violets are accompanied by hints of brioche on the finish.

## Ferrari Perle` 2018`, Trentino, £62

Characterized by a fine and persistent perlage, it opens with aromas of citrus, pineapple and grapefruit, peach and rennet apple, sponge cake and delicate honeyed notes. On the palate it is fresh with a rich body. It closes long and with a hint of summer fruit on the finish.

## **ALCOHOL FREE SPARKLING**

## Wild Idol, Sparkling White, 37.5cl £39 - 75cl £48

White has a beautiful pale straw hue and is bursting with zesty green apples and aromas of white peach and honeyed melon, finished with soft, fine bubbles. Vegan, gluten-free and low calorie, it is hand-crafted using wine-making techniques with a blend of fragrant Müller-Thurgau grapes, for an authentic non-alcoholic wine alternative.

## WHITE WINE BOTTLES

## Verdicchio Valbona, Marche, £33

This is a lovely aromatic wine on the nose with a clean bouquet of acacia and a touch of honey. On the palate it is dry with a great structure and balance. The finish is vibrant with crisp green apple and lemon flavours.

## Pinot Grigio Fraz Hass, Alto Adige, £37.50

This Pinot Grigio is intense straw-yellow in colour, with a fragrant floral bouquet of sage, hay, almonds and sandalwood. After some time in the bottle, notes of honey and lime blossom develop. On the palate, it is fresh and medium bodied with great finesse and elegance.

## Gavi di Gavi, La Luganara, Piedmont, £38

Straw-yellow in colour with a greenish hue, this wine delights with aromas of white fruit, stone fruit and lime zest, which are immediately beguiling and are followed by a subtle yet persistent bouquet of green apples. The palate is well balanced with fresh acidity and good structure, and there are almond notes on the finish.

## Vermentino Antonella Corda, Sardegna, £41

The nose is fragrant and intense with aromas of peach and tropical fruit with aromatic hints of sage and capers. The aromas carry on to the palate where the refreshing acidity brightens the wine. The finish is long and lingering.

## Villa Bucci, Verdicchio Classico Superiore, Marche, £44

Deep straw yellow in colour, this wine has a layered bouquet with notes of Golden Delicious apples, almonds and Mediterranean herbs. The palate is complex with a silky texture and good body. A refreshing mineral edge contrasts with the ripe, round flavours of wildflower and honey.

## Soave Classico Pieropan, Veneto, £44

This wine is brilliant straw yellow in colour, with greenish hints. On the nose it has aromas of almond blossoms and marzipan, with a touch of citrus. On the palate it is rounded and has flavours of ripe fruit perfectly balanced by a fresh, clean acidity that enhances its long length.

## Winkl Sauvignon, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige, £46

Grapefruit, lemon, and a hint of gooseberry bring plenty of zest, softened by soft peach and melon. Grassy, herbal notes balance floral vanilla, and a touch of flint on the finish.

## La Rocca, Pieropan, Veneto, £56

Golden yellow in the glass, with intense, concentrated perfumes that follow through to the palate. It aromas of nuts and exotic fruits lead to an elegant and beautifully balanced palate, with notes of spice and a light minerality on the long finish.

## WHITE WINE BOTTLES

## Dessimis Pinot Grigio, Vie di Romans, Friuli, £64

Light golden in colour with a subtle, elegant nose of summer flowers, acacia blossom and hints of honeysuckle. The wine is lightly spiced, with the judicious oak ageing bringing notes of vanilla and cinnamon. It shows lovely buttery, honeyed and floral characters, all lifted on the finish by a lively freshness that is characteristic of this area of Italy.

## Vie di Romans Chardonnay, Friuli, £65

Light golden with a subtle, elegant nose of summer flowers, acacia blossom and hints of honeysuckle. The wine is lightly spiced, with the judicious oak ageing bringing notes of vanilla and cinnamon. The lovely character is buttery, honeyed and floral, all lifted on the finish by a lively freshness characteristic of this area of Italy.

## Quarz, Cantine Terlano, Sauvignon Blanc, Alto Adige, £88

Juicy fruit aromas and delicate minerality create a harmonious opulence. The interplay of flavours results in a well-balanced and sophisticated profile. It has a long and impressive finish.

## Collezione Privata, Isole e Olena, Chardonnay, Tuscany, £110

In the glass, this wine has an inviting golden colour. It entices with rich aromas of toasted almonds with buttery notes. On the palate, there is great balance between rich, ripe fruit, creamy brioche and complex minerality. Full-bodied, the palate extends through to a long finish.

## **RED WINE BOTTLES**

## Valpolicella Allegrini, Veneto, £37.80

This wine is ruby red in colour, with youthful highlights. On the nose, fragrant fruit with prominent notes of dark cherries and fresher hints of pepper and aromatic herbs, typical of Corvina and Corvinone, the historic varieties of this appellation. This Valpolicella is impressively lively and playful on the palate, whilst exhibiting delicacy and finesse at the same time.

## Chianti Selvapiana Rufina, Tuscany, £38.50

Lovely bright ruby in colour with a dark core and youthful rim. Its delicious ripe, blackberry fruit nose is exuberant and lightly spiced. On the palate it is ripe and juicy but still fine and elegant in the Selvapiana style, with a tight structure and lifted, floral finish.

## Barbera d'Alba, Giovanni Rosso, Piemont, £39.50

A bright nose full of plums, raspberries and blueberries with some delicate wisteria hints. This is an very easy drinking Barbera with a vibrant acidity and fleshy and juicy fruit. A great all rounder.

## Zolla Negroamaro, Puglia, £41

Very intense ruby red colour. On the nose the cherry aromas are intense with hints of prune, pomegranate, clove and dried herbs. A full-bodied warm and delicious wine, with a pleasantly fresh finish.

## **RED WINE BOTTLES**

## Etna Rosso Tornatore, Sicily, £45

Ruby red with faint purple tones, this wine has aromas of red fruits, morello cherry and black cherry. On the palate the tannis are well balanced giving it a fullness.

## Cannonau, Antonella Corda, Sardinia, £48

This Cannonau is an elegant wine with aromas of orchard fruit, raspberry, rose and delicate white pepper. Fresh fruit harmonises with the delicate warm notes from the barrel and exceptional soft tannins. Balanced and fresh, with fine tannins and a saline finish.

## Uvaggio, Preprieta` Sperino, Piedmont, £54.90

Vibrant ruby red in the glass, this wine is simple yet seductive. The middle palate is fresh and juicy, packed with aromatic red fruits and occasional hints of herbs. It has a grand texture thanks to the supple, approachable tannins and well-balanced acidity from a slow and cold fermentation process.

## Amarone, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, £57

Deep coloured and perfumed, with aromas of rich fruit cake, dried cherries and plums which give way to a modern, rounded palate, full-bodied but nicely balanced with concentrated plum pudding characters offset by an attractive smoky, vanilla spice from the oak ageing. Rich but still fresh on the finish.

## Barolo, Giovanni Rosso, Piedmont, £63

A concentrated nose with violet and roses and tightly packed cherry. This is a Barolo with lovely ripe but firm tannins that give it a fine structure. Its also incredibly fresh and bright with the cherry notes continuing to the palate. A great wine to savour or enjoy with richer foods.

## Sondraia, Bolgheri Superiore Poggio al Tesoro, Tuscany, £99

Intense ruby red. Concentrated ripe, red fruit characters with an exuberant blackcurrant compote note, further emphasised by cinnamon and nutmeg notes. Plush, warm and full, with velvety, ripe tannins giving structure to the ripe, plummy fruit on the palate with touch of rosemary and eucalyptus on the finish.

## Brunello di Montalcino Constanti 2017, Tuscany, £123

Nicely layered and concentrated, with an immediate delivery of black fruit, spice and potting soil. This vintage shows a savory personality more than it shows a sweet one, and the tannins are quite soft and velvety. This is an open-knit Brunello from a hot and dry vintage to drink in the medium-term.
