SPARKLING WINE

Prosecco Dirupo Sup. Valdobbiadene DOCG, Andreola, 75cl, £39.50

Straw yellow colour with a lingering creamy froth, ushers in fragrances of hawthorn, acacia blossoms, and citrus fruit. Rounded and generous in the mouth with delicate finished fine perlage.

Prosecco Rose` Torresella, Veneto, 75cl, £37

A pale pink hue is the sophisticated introduction to a fragrant floral bouquet, with hints of citrus and a distinct aroma of red berry fruits on the nose.

Ferrari Maximum, Blanc de Blancs, Trentino, 37.5cl £36, 75cl £56

Light straw yellow in colour with a fine perlage. It shows pleasant fruit aromas with hints of bread crust and hazelnut. The palate is elegant with a very persistent velvety texture with a light fruity note of ripe apples, pleasant hints of yeast and sweet almonds and a faintly aromatic quality that is typical of Chardonnay.

Ferrari Maximum, Rose`, Trentino, £60.99

Elegant pink hue with a persistent perlage. The nose shows delicate aromas of yeast, deriving from the long bottle ageing, and berries that are typical of Pinot Noir. The palate has flavours of raspberry, wild strawberry and violets are accompanied by hints of brioche on the finish.

Ferrari Perle` 2018`, Trentino, £62

Characterized by a fine and persistent perlage, it opens with aromas of citrus, pineapple and grapefruit, peach and renet apple, sponge cake and delicate honeyed notes. On the palate it is fresh with a rich body . It closes long and with a hint of summer fruit on the finish.

ALCOHOL FREE SPARKLING

Wild Idol, Sparkling White, 37.5cl £39 - 75cl £48

White has a beautiful pale straw hue and is bursting with zesty green apples and aromas of white peach and honeyed melon, finished with soft, fine bubbles. Vegan, gluten-free and low calorie, it is hand-crafted using wine-making techniques with a blend of fragrant Müller-Thurgau grapes, for an authentic non-alcoholic wine alternative.

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WHITE WINE BOTTLES

Verdicchio Valbona, Marche, £33

This is a lovely aromatic wine on the nose with a clean bouquet of acacia and a touch of honey. On the palate it is dry with a great structure and balance. The finish is vibrant with crisp green apple and lemon flavours.

Falanghina, Ercolino, Campania, £36

Citrusy notes, lime, grapefruit and kiwi. Delicate floral scents, of jasmine in particular, create a complex and lingering bouquet. Intense minerality on the palate with medium persistence.

Soave Classico Pieropan, Veneto, £38

This wine is brilliant straw yellow in colour, with greenish hints. On the nose it has aromas of almond blossoms and marzipan, with a touch of citrus. On the palate it is rounded and has flavours of ripe fruit perfectly balanced by a fresh, clean acidity that enhances its long length.

Camarà, Chardonnay, Tenuta Mazzolino, Lombardy, £40

The wine is light straw yellow in colour. On the nose, it shows aromas of acacia flowers, ripe white citrus, and peach, with a subtle grassy undertone. The palate reveals flavours of canary melon and white peach, evolving into lemongrass and green almonds. This pure Chardonnay showcases lovely length and a crisp, clean finish.

Vermentino di Sardegna, Antonella Corda, 75cl, £41.50

The nose is fragrant and intense with aromas of orange blossom, grapefruit, lemon, sage and capers. On the palate, a vibrant acidity marries notes of sea salt, complete with a long, complex finish.

Villa Bucci, Verdicchio Classico Superiore, Marche, £44

Deep straw yellow in colour, this wine has a layered bouquet with notes of Golden Delicious apples, almonds and Mediterranean herbs. The palate is complex with a silky texture and good body. A refreshing mineral edge contrasts with the ripe, round flavours of wildflower and honey.

Terlaner Cuvée Cantina Terlano 75cl, £45

Brilliant pale yellow colour with green nuances. On the nose green apple and white peach combine with fine nuances of lemon balm and mint to create the typical aroma of the classic Terlano. On the palate the peach is very strong, too, lending the Terlano its lively but at the same time very mellow character. The multifaceted, well structured flavor derives from an interplay of freshness and minerality and also has a wonderfully persistent finish.

Kreuth, Chardonnay, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige, £52

Kreuth Chardonnay offers a fine acidity, creamy structure and an elegant play of aromas. Thanks to its complexity and mineral note, this powerful Chardonnay from the Terlano DOC area is a very long-lived wine.

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WHITE WINE BOTTLES

La Rocca, Pieropan, Veneto, £56

Golden yellow in the glass, with intense, concentrated perfumes that follow through to the palate. It aromas of nuts and exotic fruits lead to an elegant and beautifully balanced palate, with notes of spice and a light minerality on the long finish.

Dessimis Pinot Grigio, Vie di Romans, Friuli, £64

Light golden in colour with a subtle, elegant nose of summer flowers, acacia blossom and hints of honeysuckle. The wine is lightly spiced, with the judicious oak ageing bringing notes of vanilla and cinnamon. It shows lovely buttery, honeyed and floral characters, all lifted on the finish by a lively freshness that is characteristic of this area of Italy.

Vie di Romans Chardonnay, Friuli, £65

Light golden with a subtle, elegant nose of summer flowers, acacia blossom and hints of honeysuckle. The wine is lightly spiced, with the judicious oak ageing bringing notes of vanilla and cinnamon. The lovely character is buttery, honeyed and floral, all lifted on the finish by a lively freshness characteristic of this area of Italy.

Quarz, Cantine Terlano, Sauvignon Blanc, Alto Adige, £88

Juicy fruit aromas and delicate minerality create a harmonious opulence. The interplay of flavours results in a well-balanced and sophisticated profile. It has a long and impressive finish.

Collezione Privata, Isole e Olena, Chardonnay, Tuscany, £110

In the glass, this wine has an inviting golden colour. It entices with rich aromas of toasted almonds with buttery notes. On the palate, there is great balance between rich, ripe fruit, creamy brioche and complex minerality. Full-bodied, the palate extends through to a long finish.

RED WINE BOTTLES

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Gran Sasso, Abruzzo, £33.90

Dry, Red, Full Bodied, Smooth, Juicy, Red and Black Fruit, Spicy, Easy Drinking, Food Friendly.

Valpolicella Allegrini, Veneto, £37.80

This wine is ruby red in colour, with youthful highlights. On the nose, fragrant fruit with prominent notes of dark cherries and fresher hints of pepper and aromatic herbs, typical of Corvina and Corvinone, the historic varieties of this appellation. This Valpolicella is impressively lively and playful on the palate, whilst exhibiting delicacy and finesse at the same time.

Barbera d'Alba, Giovanni Rosso, Piedmont, £39.50

A bright nose full of plums, raspberries and blueberries with some delicate wisteria hints. This is an very easy drinking Barbera with a vibrant acidity and fleshy and juicy fruit. A great all rounder.

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RED WINE BOTTLES

Cannonau, Antonella Corda, Sardinia, £48

This Cannonau is an elegant wine with aromas of orchard fruit, raspberry, rose and delicate white pepper. Fresh fruit harmonises with the delicate warm notes from the barrel and exceptional soft tannins. Balanced and fresh, with fine tannins and a saline finish.

Fantini Farnese Edizione Cinque Autoctoni, Abruzzo, £56

Deep ruby red in colour, with intense and persistent aromas of cherry and blackcurrant, with notes of herbs, cinnamon, cloves, cocoa and liquorice and a touch of minerality. The palate reveals a balanced structure with a lifted, elegant freshness. Soft, supple tannins lead to a long finish.

Amarone, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, £57

Deep coloured and perfumed, with aromas of rich fruit cake, dried cherries and plums which give way to a modern, rounded palate, full-bodied but nicely balanced with concentrated plum pudding characters offset by an attractive smoky, vanilla spice from the oak ageing. Rich but still fresh on the finish.

Chianti Rufina Riserva, Bucerchiale, Tuscany, £59

Tremendous depth of colour with great intensity on the nose and a powerful, fruit packed palate, unusual for the Chianti Rufina zone which is usually characterised by its leaner, elegant wines. Ripe raspberry and spicy cherry fruit, with a touch of herbs and violets on the palate, robust tannins and the long, fine finish which is the hallmark of the Selvapiana wines.

Monticol, Pinot Nero Riserva, Alto Adige, £63

Intense ruby to garnet red colour. The Pinot Noir presents itself as a multifaceted wine on the nose, where the delicate primary fruit aromas of wild strawberries and blackberries blend with restrained aromas of tobacco and flint, and notes of white field mushrooms. Well balanced with a mineral elegance that makes it dance on the palate. This red wine has a long and exciting finish.

Brunello di Montalcino Constanti 2017, Tuscany, £123

Nicely layered and concentrated, with an immediate delivery of black fruit, spice and potting soil. This vintage shows a savory personality more than it shows a sweet one, and the tannins are quite soft and velvety. This is an open-knit Brunello from a hot and dry vintage to drink in the medium-term.

Quintarelli, Valpolicella Superiore, Veneto, £138

The wine is dense and rich, but never heavy. Tannic grip, beautiful acidity, concentration and ripeness, and everything comes together seamlessly showing the skill and passion of a master craftsman. Flavour of black cherries and plums, with earthiness, forest scents, roses, prunes, cocoa powder, and minerals.

Flaccianello del Pieve, Tuscany, £149

Faccianello is rapidly becoming one of the most demanded wines in Italy. It is made from a selection of Fontodi's best Sangiovese. The 90-acre hilltop vineyard in the Panzano area of Chianti has an amphitheater shape that allows the grapes to fully ripen to give a powerful, dry red wine that ages beautifully.
